**SUBJECT : SAFETY RULES WITHIN PORT OPERATIONS AREA**

(Updated over ADT-COM/06/2009 DATED 27<sup>th</sup> August 2009)

In our continued effort to create a safe working environment at Abu Dhabi Terminals, we request our valued customers to comply with the following requirements effective 10 September 2010:

- No persons will be permitted to enter operations' areas without basic personal protective equipment - PPE (jacket; safety shoes and helmet)
- All drivers must obey the maximum speed limit of 30 km/h
- Mobile phones must not be used when driving in the port facilities
- Seat belts must be worn
- A beacon light must be used when driving inside Container Terminal
- Suppliers requesting permits for performing bunkering / hot work are required to equip themselves with at least 2 fire extinguishers and sufficient safety cones for barricading work areas

Strict enforcement of the above safety procedures by security personnel will result in individuals who fail to comply being refused entry to/escorted from the Port premises.

We look forward to your cooperation and support in achieving our objective of a safe and accident free Port.
