Sub: Instructions for the clearance of Imported Food Consignments.

Based on instructions received from Abu Dhabi Food Control Authority & Abu Dhabi Customs, We are advising the same for all above Customers to comply accordingly.

Abu Dhabi Food Control Authority (ADFC) has taken the initiative to implement a Risk Based Inspection system on all imported Foods arriving via ADT (Mina Zayed).The system will be launched officially on 18th November 2009.

In compliance with international standard on inspection of imported foods, it is ‘mandatory’ for all food containers to process through Yellow channel (i.e. cargo examination) and Red channel (i.e. sampling & Lab analysis) and are also required to be shifted for inspection at C9, food Inspection centre in the main cold store. These procedures are to be carried out prior to shipment clearance or conditional /bonded release to customers warehouse by submitting an undertaking letter.

In order to undergo the Yellow & Red Channel inspection at C9 area, the relevant charges are applicable and to be settled by the Customers directly for the services availed, as per ADT tariff, which subject to amendment from time to time.
